The 'hand layup' technique is a hands-on craft. You will clean the molds, use hand sprayers to apply gel coat on molds, use hand sanders to scuff, smooth and buff the molds and fiberglass parts, and you will also roll fiberglass cloths using resin onto molds. In addition, you will trim parts from molds using a hand trimming and grinding tool. This work requires your attention and precision. The position pays a minimum of \$33,280 to \$40,000 per year, paid hourly.
